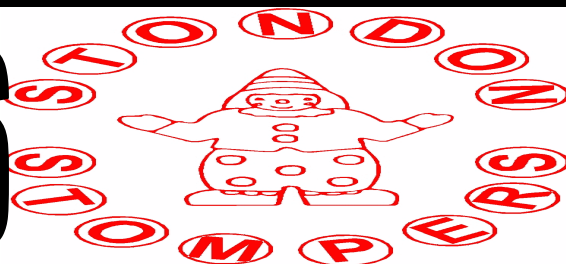

After a very successful planning meeting back in April we have enjoyed lots of activities based around 'Spring time and Growing.

The children have been planting runner beans after reading the story of Jack and beanstalk; We've planted beans in bags so we can see them grow and measure them.
