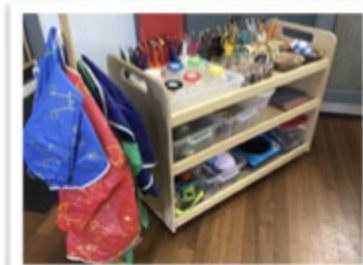


Stondon Stompers Pre-school
